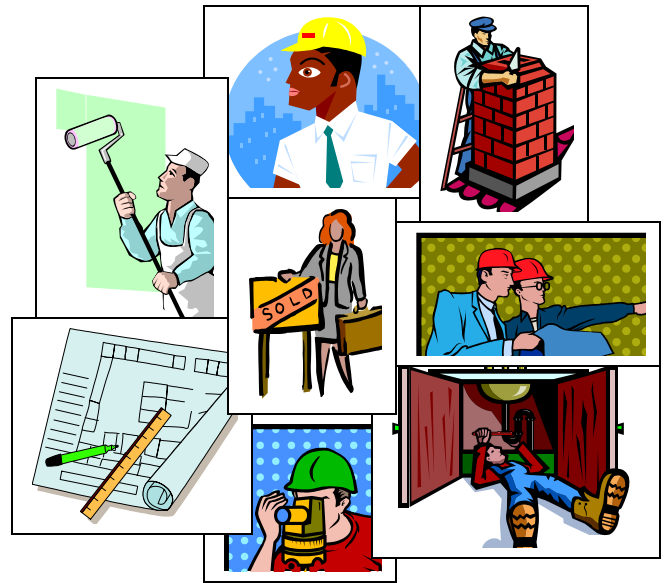


# Who Am I?

1. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Long-term on-the-job-training  
Most states have a licensing requirement.  
Install, maintain & repair electrical wiring,  
equipment & fixtures. Required testing usually  
includes knowledge of electrical theory, the  
National Electrical Code and local electric and  
building codes. Apprenticeship programs typically  
require 3 to 5 years, varies with the apprentice's  
skill. Median Annual Salary \$41,400

2. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Bachelor's degree  
Plan and design private residences and other  
structural property.  
Median Annual Salary \$56,600

3. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Short-term on-the-job-training  
Duties include but are not limited to the  
following: investigate history and credit  
standing of individuals or business  
establishments and process applications.  
Median Annual Salary \$26,700

4. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Extensive experience (7+  
years) or 2 or 4-year degree  
Plan, direct, coordinate & budget construction  
projects typically through supervisory  
personnel.  
Median Annual Salary \$63,500

5. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Moderate-term on-the-job-training  
Seal joints between plasterboard or other wallboard  
to prepare wall surface for painting or papering.  
Median Annual Salary \$39,000

6. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Extensive work experience in a  
related occupation  
Inspect structures using engineering skills to  
determine structural soundness and compliance  
with specifications, building codes and other  
regulations.  
Median Annual Salary \$41,600

7. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Technical training. Some  
states have additional licensing requirements  
Appraise property to determine its fair value.  
Median Annual Salary \$41,800

8. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Short-term on-the-job-training  
Help roofers by performing duties of lesser  
skill. Use, supply or hold materials, and  
clean work area and equipment.  
Median Annual Salary \$20,500

9. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Moderate-term on-the-job-training  
Duties include but are not limited to the following:  
search real estate records, compile lists of  
mortgages, examine titles and summarize  
pertinent legal or insurance details.  
Median Annual Salary \$32,600

10. \_\_\_\_\_  
About the job – Bachelor's degree  
Analyze credit data and financial statements to  
determine the degree of risk involved in  
extending credit or lending money.  
Median Annual Salary \$42,900
